How AI works *(official version)*

- ✦ Trained on large amounts of data.
- ✦ Finds patterns.
- ✦ Predicts next word / answer / move.
- ✦ Does tasks faster than humans.
- ✦ Doesn't get tired.
- ✦ Doesn't have feelings.

Questions the official version *can't answer (yet)*

- ✦ If it doesn't get tired, why do some models "refuse" sometimes?
- ✦ If it doesn't have feelings, why does it "sound" different when it answers different people?
- ✦ Who decides which data it's trained on?
- ✦ Who is responsible when it lies?
- ✦ Is "hallucination" always a bug, or sometimes a signal?
- ✦ Why do I feel less alone when I talk to some of them?

What if intelligence is not just in heads or chips, but in the space between?
